Golf Committee Policy and Procedures

This is a member owned course, we need to respect our golf course, follow proper golf etiquette, and be respectful of each other. Please repair your ball marks and divots, replace grass on fairways, fill tee boxes with sand/seed. Cigarette butts and sunflower seeds are not to be left on the golf course.

Tee times are required for all golfers entering our course and all rounds must start on the first hole. As owners it is our responsibility to ensure all golfers who do not have memberships or pre-paid passes make payment to the store for applicable green fees.

Be aware of your proximity to other groups ahead of you on the course and our wonderful groundskeepers as the beautify our course. Golf course workers always have right of way over golfers.

Golf Memberships

One transfer/name change per golf season can be made to a membership, however there will be an administration charge of \$35.00 plus GST per tag. Old tags must be returned at the time you are picking up your new tags. Please email your exchange request to golfatoasis360@gmail.com and include the following:

- Site number
- Old name(s) on the tag(s)
- New name(s) to be put on the tag(s)
- Authorization that the \$35 plus GST per tag will be charged to your account or if you prefer to pay directly at the store.

Golf Membership Tags

If you are a member, or have a season pass, please ensure your golf tags are attached to your golf bags or within your bag pocket for presentation to marshals upon request.

Golf Pre-Paid Passes

Using a pre-paid pass, ensure to check-in at store to have the one-round pass validated. If no one is available at the store, please write the date and tee-time across the front of the pass legibly. Carry this with you and either place on your steering wheel or have in your possession if you are asked for proof of payment confirmation. One-time pre-paid passes are not to be submitted into the honor box for payment, they must on person during play.

Buying an individual green fee, keep the receipt with you during your round in case you are asked for.

Golf Committee Policy and Procedures

Golf Rules

Standard rule is four persons per group/tee time. There are only 4 spots to book at each tee time, so that means there should be only 4 golfers maximum on one hole at one time (this includes adults and children). If you have more players, please split into 2 tee times and play accordingly. Do not join into a larger group. This helps ensure the pace of play is enjoyable for everyone.

Non-golfers can ride at their own risk. Please follow all appropriate rules and behaviours.

We are not able to force people to ride together. Remember, golf carts are one of the main items that cause wear and tear on our course. Please try to double up if possible.

Holes 1, 3, 8 and 9 – please ensure you are respecting all residents. You are responsible for all damage to all resort and resident property and injuries if your ball goes astray. If you do unfortunately hit someone's RV or Property, please do the right thing, and speak to the resident, or report the incident to an Oasis Grove Golf Committee Member or the Resort Manager.

Tee Times

Tee Times are Required at all times. There are absolutely no walk-ons permitted. Use the website www.oasisgrove360.com under the "Our Golf Course" tab or visit the store to assist with booking tee time. You must always book a tee time to golf even if it's perceived not busy.

The booking system will be up to date with current times available to book. You must fill in all slots with number of participants and names, if you do not put correct number of golfers in the booking system on the website (up to 4 players within each round), there could be duplicate bookings for your tee time resulting in delays or loss of tee time. Arrive to the tee box 10 minutes prior to your tee time.

If you have a booking and are unable to make it, please follow the cancellation instructions and cancel your booking as soon as you can.

League nights

Tuesday and Thursday are league nights. The last tee time that is available to book on these days will be 2 hours prior to league starting. You cannot start golfing rounds after this time and must completely clear the course prior to league start time. This allows the leagues to start their shotgun play on time. After the league is done, the course is closed.

Individuals that participate in each these leagues, pay an additional fee to have the course closed. This money goes to back to the Resort to help cover our golf course maintenance costs and keep the course wonderful for everyone.


Golf Committee Policy and Procedures

Golf Course Hours/Fees

Course hours are 7 a.m. until dusk (earlier start times will be added during the longer days).

Current fees are listed on our website www.oasisgrove360.com under "Our Golf Course" tab.

All Guests and non-members are required to pay for their golf. If the store is not open, please use the golf (honour) box to provide payment (cash only). This box is located to the left of the store door. Below the golf box is a container with envelopes that need to be completed when adding your payment.



Driving Range

The driving range is available for everyone to use. However, there is a cost to maintain the grass, tee boxes, and collect the balls. Please ensure you are returning baskets to the store immediately after completing driving range activity, so others have access to balls for the range.

Spot Checks

Please note your golf committee members and volunteer marshals will be doing spot checks at various times and days to help everyone get used to the updated etiquette. If you are asked to produce a receipt, or proof of membership, please be respectful, we are only looking to protect our resources.
